- He's also a breaststroke specialist, who made promising performances at the 2016 Rio Olympic Games, taking 6th place at just 19 years old.
- In January 2017, he became the first swimmer ever to break the 2:07 mark in the 200m breaststroke, swimming 2:06.67, becoming the new Senior World Record holder.
